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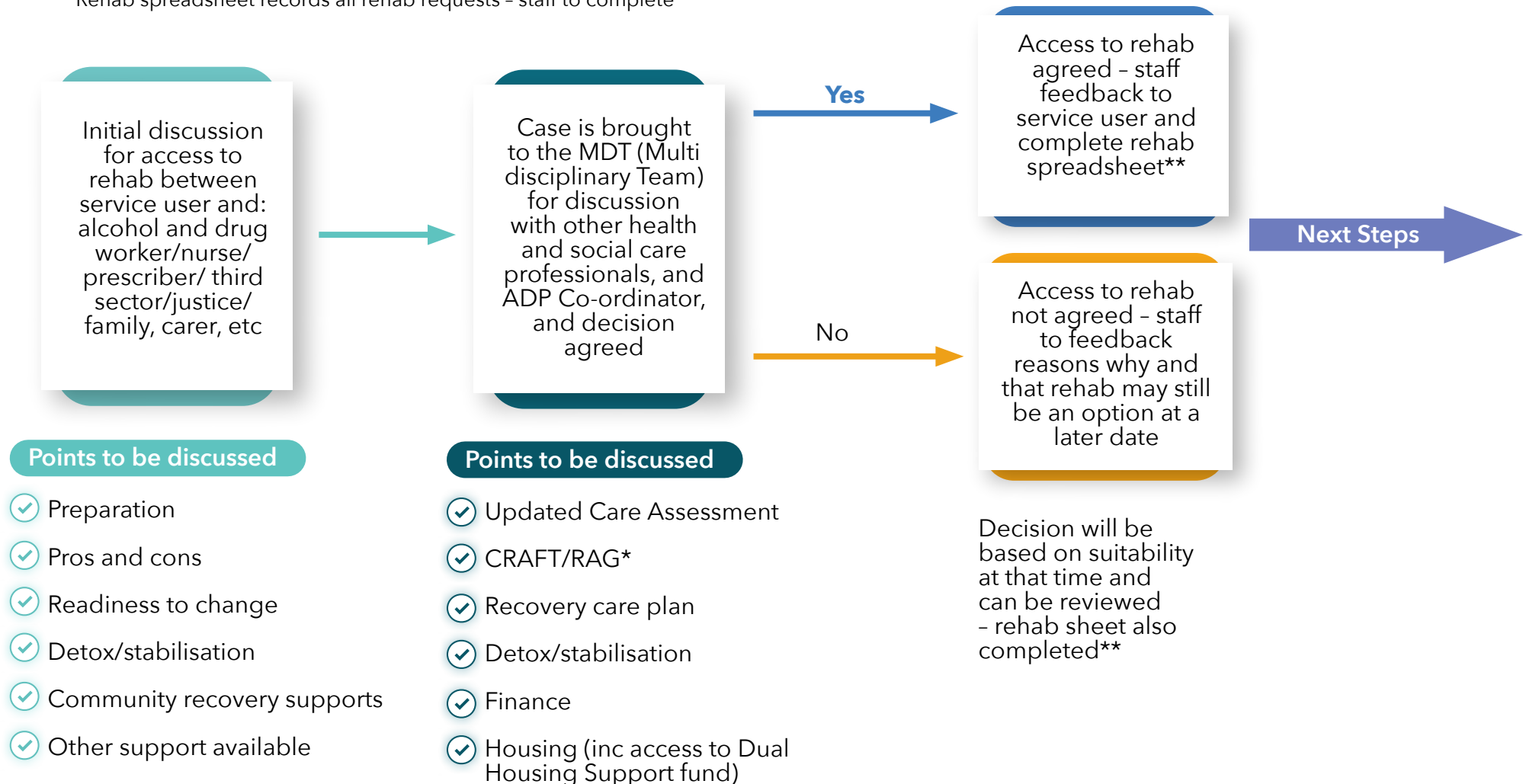
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# REHAB DISCUSSION & DECISION PROCESS

\* All cases have a RAG status regarding the level of risk:

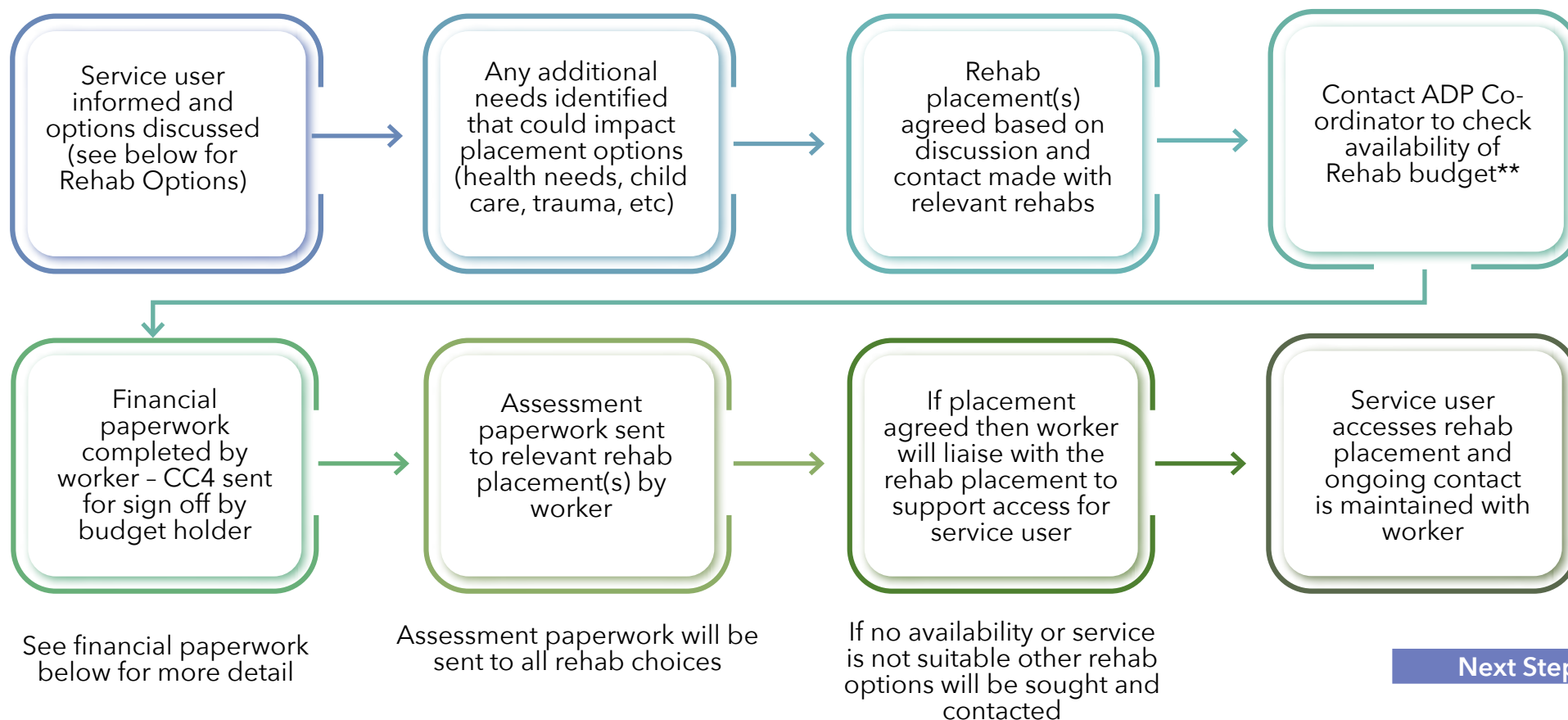
R - Red / A - Amber / G - Green

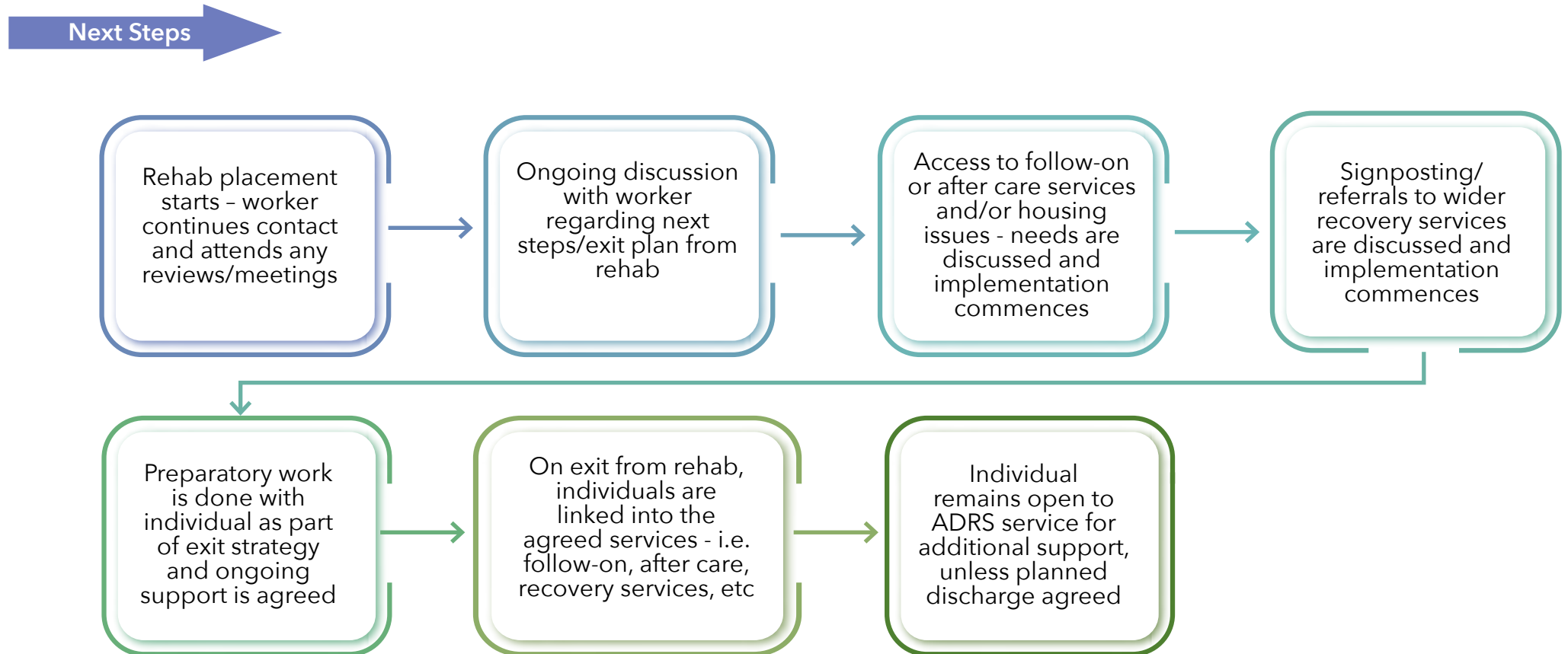

# FINANCIAL PAPERWORK

Social Work Access to Resource (CC4) is completed by the individual's worker, signed by the Team Manager and the Senior Manager (budget holder). ADP Co-ordinator involved in this process too, to ensure the 'Rehab budget' is the first budget accessed. If this budget has been fully spent then other budgets will be looked at.

## REHAB OPTIONS – SCOTLAND



Some rehab options are tied into local authority contracts and may not be available for areas outwith that local authority. Rehab selection is based on individual choice, but also needs to take into consideration availability and location to ensure continued support from local teams. Rehab placements on this list vary based on:
