1	Welcome			
	J MacDonald welcomed everyone to the meeting.			
2	Feedback from Isobel Mair/Craigmarloch Visits			
	Craigmarloch			
	The safety considerations throughout the school were well thought of during the design stage and the outdoor areas were impressive. There was also a secure outdoor area for vulnerable children. There was good built in storage and there were areas of covered outdoor areas which can be used all year round. Members also noted that the sheltered bus drop off points were valuable.			
	Members felt the school felt inviting with lots of natural light and the school was inclusive for all disabilities. The classroom spaces included quiet areas that members felt were beneficial.			
	The school had good built in storage and a good allocation of equipment storage.  Members also felt that there was a great benefit to the link to the high school for joined up working opportunities.			
	Members noted aspects which they would change including the layout of the dining room as it was felt that this was too big and noisy. Members also noted that the nursery within the school is not used by nursery pupils; however this is due to no nursery pupils registered to the school for the current year.

	Members liked the floor to ceiling windows and felt the school felt very light and airy. The school also had dedicated rooms for art, science and has a separate unit for life and living skills which members thought was very beneficial.			
	The school is a two storey building; the second storey is used for staff and admin only. There were also separate entrances for staff/ visitor and for pupils that members felt was valuable.			
	Members agreed that the following the visits, it was clear that the site which is chosen will have to be extensive due to the requirements of school, outdoor play and parking.
