Executive Summary

On the 30th January 2016 the Improvement Service published the Local Government Benchmarking Framework indicator data for the 14/15 reporting period. The indicators have been set to support Councils to; understand relative levels of performance in order to provide focused scrutiny. The Framework also aims to increase understanding of performance variations and share good practice developments across Local Authority Areas.

The Council has continued to sustain improved performance with the majority (55%) of all indicators for which data is currently available reporting improvements when compared with the prior year.

The Council's rank performance when compared across Scottish Councils now reports 28% of our indicators within the top quartile. This is an improved position when compared to the 21% reported in the prior year. By comparison however, the number of indicators in the bottom quartile has also increased by from 12% to 17%. Overall the Council has improved or sustained its indicative rank position for 55% of all indicators and declined in 45%







Cost Per Primary School Pupil







Cost Per Secondary School Pupil







Cost Per Pre-School Education Registration









% of Pupils Gaining 5+ Awards at level 6 (SIMD)







% of Adults Satisfied with Local Schools







% of Pupils Entering Positive Destinations








Corporate Services

Support Services as a % of Total Gross Expenditure







The percentage of the highest paid 5% of Employees who are women





The Cost per Dwelling of collecting Council Tax





Average time between time of complaint and attendance on site











Sickness Absence Days per Teacher











Percentage of Income due from Council Tax Received







Percentage of Invoices Paid within 30 days







Older Persons (65+) Home Care Costs per hour







SDS Spend on Adults as a % of total spend





% of people 65+ with intensive needs receiving care at home





The Percent of Total Household waste that is Recycled





The Percent of Adults Satisfied with Street Cleaning







Gross rent arrears as a percentage of rent due for the reporting year







Percentage of rent lost due to voids







Percentage of Dwellings meeting SHQS





Percentage of Council Dwellings that are Energy Efficient







Proportion of operational buildings suitable for their current use







Proportion of Internal Floor Area of Buildings in Satisfactory Condition






