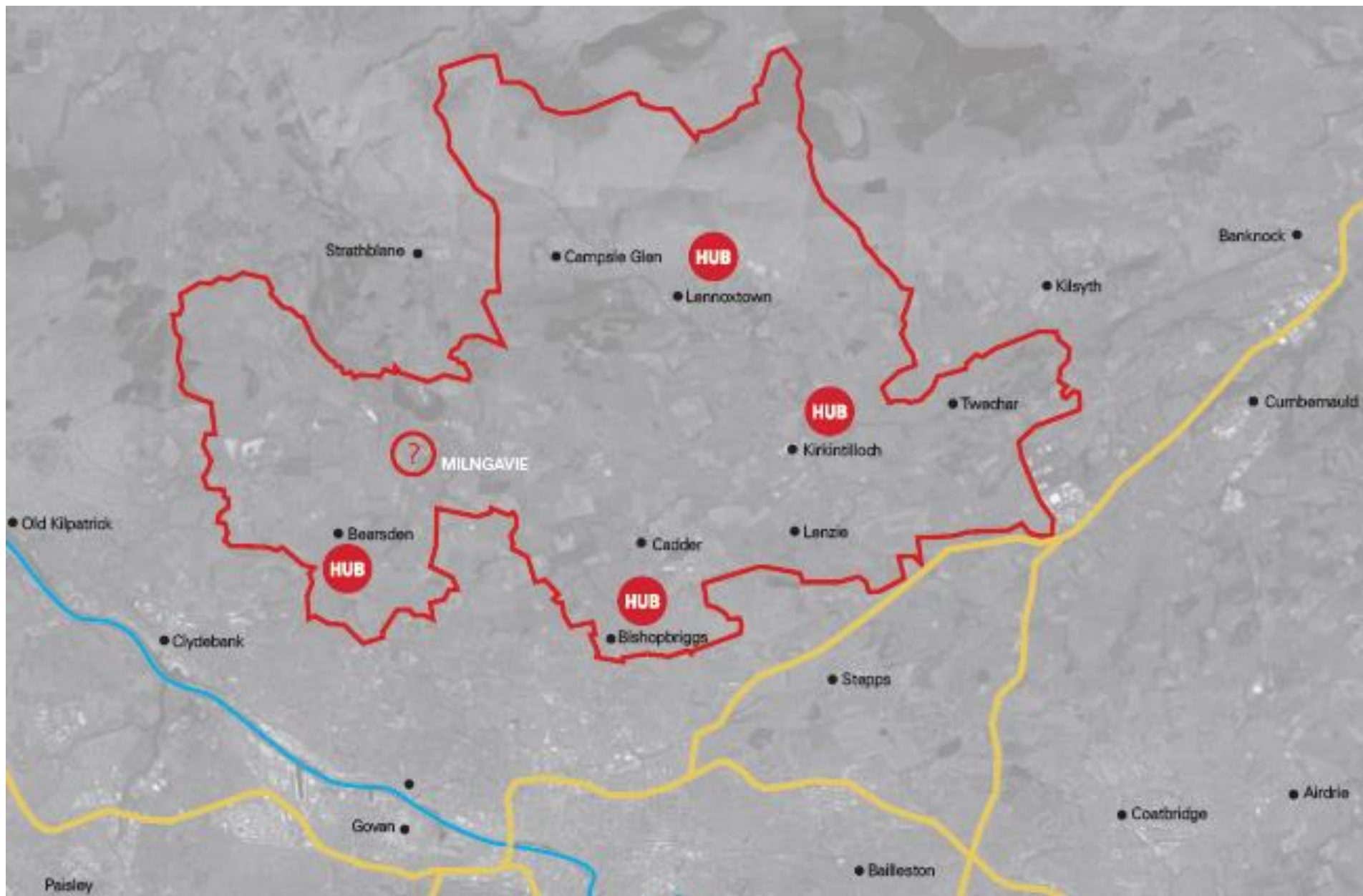

Location Requirements

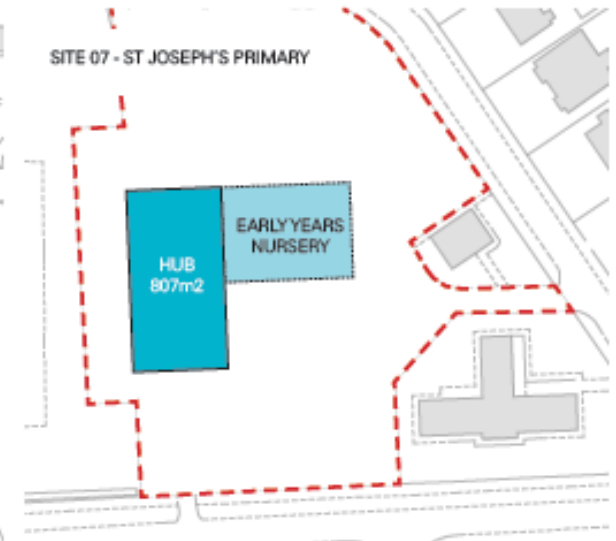
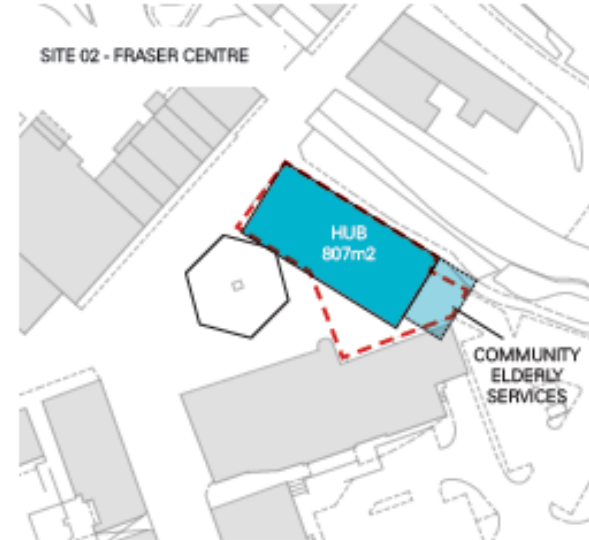
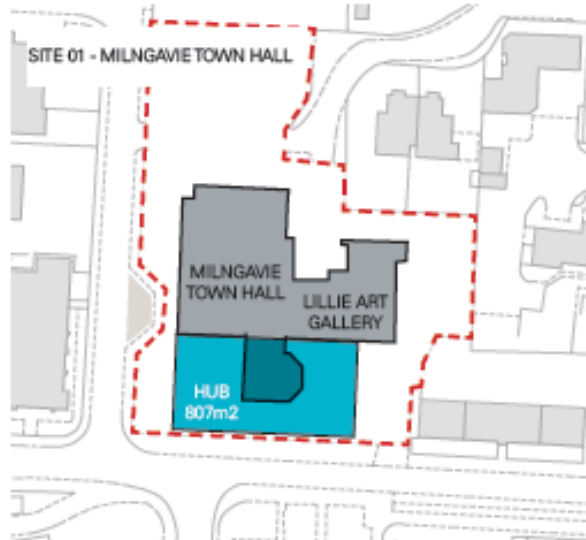

Site Selection

Seven sites were considered for their current use and the inclusion of Milngavie Community Hub development. Only one site proved viable to meet all requirements.



Summary of Options Appraisal

- Consideration given to
 - Size of site
 - Proximity to Town Centre
 - No diminishing of town centre car parking
 - Accessibility
 - Public transport
 - Proximity to car parking
 - Walking distance from precinct
 - Best option for service continuation during build

Preferred Site

- One site meets all criteria and within town centre footprint
 - Co-locating facilities from
 - Town Hall and Lesser Hall
 - Lillie Art Gallery
 - Community Education Centre
 - Library
 - Early design options prepared
 - Two potential approaches

- Feedback on process so far
 - Inform Council decision
 - Appointment of design team and development partner
 - Development of delivery timescales
 - Anticipated site start - Early Summer 2020
 - Anticipated facility opening – Summer 2021
