**Declaration of Results**  
**Bishopbriggs South Ward**  
**04/05/2012**

I declare that the result of the election in the Bishopbriggs South Ward is as follows.

There are 3 councillors to be elected.

The percentage poll was 41.78%. There were 3867 valid papers and 63 rejected papers.

The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected is 967.

The first preference votes received by each of the candidates and the stage at which any candidate was elected is as:

<b>On which anything is written or marked by which the voter can be identified except the printed number and other unique identifying mark on the back</b>	0
<b>Which is unmarked or void for uncertainty</b>	12
