## 3. CHARGES

As many services were unable to recommence during the Covid-19 pandemic and during the lockdown periods, there was no increase in charges in the 2021/22 budget. Prior to that, in 2019/20 a 4% increase in charges was applied across all charging areas.

## 4. COUNCIL TAX

Scottish Government funding to local authorities is often conditional on a maximum permitted rise in Council Tax. For 2021/22 the maximum permitted increase in Council Tax was 3% and this was agreed for East Dunbartonshire.

Given that the funding gap for delivering Council services identifies continued savings required for 2022/23, with a requirement to find an additional £xxm in savings over the coming years, increasing Council Tax levels is one way of helping to bridge the gap.
