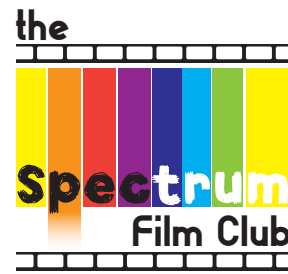


Autism friendly screenings



Here are some of the ways that we have tried to make the Spectrum Film Club autism friendly

- We have created an 'access guide' which breaks down what to expect when you arrive here

- There are signs for the toilets and entrance & exit
