

The above total cost does not include wider social costs that estimate the value of non-paid work and intangible social costs associated with people who experience premature mortality from alcohol-related diseases. As these costs are hard to estimate accurately they have been excluded from the overall total, but are believed to be somewhere in the range of £18.03m-£32.97m for East Dunbartonshire.
