I wish to formally object to planning application TP/ED/26/0104 on the following grounds -

Conflict with -
Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981
Nature Conservation (Scotland) Act 2004
NPF4 - Policy 3, Policy 6, Policy 20

Currently in Whitegates Park, there are wild orchids present, which are protected in Scotland. The loss of wild orchids would represent a significant and unnecessary ecological harm, contrary to Scotland's stated commitments to biodiversity protection and environmental stewardship.

To choose to destroy an ecosystem, in the climate of awareness of protecting our planet for future generations, is quite frankly, unbelievable.

The Planning officer should be mindful that the school could be built/refurbished on the current site.
