

FORMATION OF GOOD HABITS IN PUPILS

The Schools General (Scotland) Regulations 1975 require the education authority "to ensure that care is taken to develop in pupils in attendance at every school reasonable and responsible social attitudes and relationships, to cultivate in such pupils consideration for others, and to encourage in such pupils the practice of good manners, good attitudes to work, initiative and self reliance and habits of personal hygiene and cleanliness".

Your attention is drawn to this paragraph of the 1975 regulations and I would ask you to take whatever steps you believe necessary to meet this requirement in your school.
