DOOR CHECKLIST - FINGER ENTRAPMENT

The extent of the risk posed by each door or gate to people depends on: -

The likelihood of young children or vulnerable people being in a position to place their fingers in any pinch point that exists which could be influenced by

- the position/use of the door/gate
- frequency with which young children or vulnerable person(s) use it
- the likelihood that young or vulnerable person(s) will congregate next to a door/gate, with limited close supervision, e.g., queuing for lunch or toilet facilities
- the age and physical/mental abilities of children/vulnerable person(s)
- level of supervision and control exercised over children/vulnerable person(s) when using the door

The above factors need to be considered to establish a risk rating (High, Medium, Low) for each door.
