

1.0 Purpose

1.1 There may be occasions when a liquor licence application or planning applications is proposed which could, if approved, adversely affect the environment of a school or centre.

2.0 Scope

2.1 This procedure applies to all planning applications which could adversely affect the environment of an educational establishment within East Dunbartonshire Council.

4.0 Procedure

- 4.1 Education Service objections to applications for liquor licences or planning applications can only be lodged through the Central Education Team.
- 4.2 Accordingly, if any such application is made which a head of establishment considers might, if granted, have a detrimental effect on an educational establishment, contact should be made with the Central Education Team immediately by telephone so that the appropriate steps can be taken to allow the council's Legal and Democratic Services department to lodge an objection.
- 4.3 While no specific delegation is made in connection with objections to applications for other forms of licence which might have an impact on the education service locally, heads of establishments are advised that the first step in putting forward objections in relation to the education service should be to contact the Central Education Team so that the best means of dealing with each individual case can be determined.
