I support the relocation of the Academy to Whitegates. I understand the benefits of ensuring the current Lenzie Academy site at Myrtle Avenue provides biodiversity enhancement and new public open space as compensation for the loss of these at Whitegates.

I support retaining the Myrtle Avenue site for the community and I would not like it to be sold to developers, nor to remain derelict after the current school ceases to be used.

The current school is not fit for purpose, and I look forward to East Dunbartonshire Council granting the three interconnected applications at the same time: TP/ED/26/0340 (conservation area demolition), TP/ED/26/0341 (new park) and TP/ED/26/0104 (new school).
