## **Police Information Letter to Parents/Guardians - East Dunbartonshire**

### **Dear Parent or Guardian,**

As we approach the school holiday periods, we would like to make you aware of the work being carried out in partnership with East Dunbartonshire Council to keep young people safe and support our communities.

During the holidays, Community Policing Teams, and School Liaison Officers will be conducting targeted patrols in areas where anti-social behaviour has previously been reported. This activity will be supported by the Council's Community Wardens.

These patrols are undertaken only for legitimate policing purposes, and officers will engage with young people solely in response to specific complaints or behaviour observed by officers, and not through random stops.

If police officers identify a young person in circumstances indicating that they may be involved in, or closely associating with, anti-social behaviour, we may notify parents or guardians. This communication is intended to ensure that families are aware of concerns at an early stage so they can take steps to support and safeguard their child.

Our aim is to help parents make informed decisions and reduce the likelihood of young people being drawn into situations that could place them at risk.

Our priority is the safety and wellbeing of young people. Areas associated with anti-social behaviour may expose them to unsafe environments, peer pressure, or situations that could escalate into criminality without intervention.

Early engagement with families helps prevent issues from developing and supports positive decision-making.
