(B812, AUCHINAIRN ROAD AND BISHOPBRIGGS RELIEF ROAD)

(30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2003

The East Dunbartonshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 81(1), 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The East Dunbartonshire Council (B812, Auchinairn Road and Bishopbriggs Relief Road) (30 mph and 40 mph Speed Limits) Order 2003 and shall come into operation on 7th April 2003

2. In this order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"Vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind, drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power.

3. The length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 (1) of the Act, which imposes a speed limit of 30 mph on restricted roads.

4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

SCHEDULE 1


30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length of Road in East Dunbartonshire

1. That length of the B812, Auchinairn Road from a point 81 metres east of the junction with the C189, Standburn Road northeastwards for a distance of 215 metres or thereby, including Greenacres Roundabout, to a point 192 metres northeast of the extended northeast kerbline of Letham Drive, Bishopbriggs.




SCHEDULE 2


40 MPH SPEED LIMIT

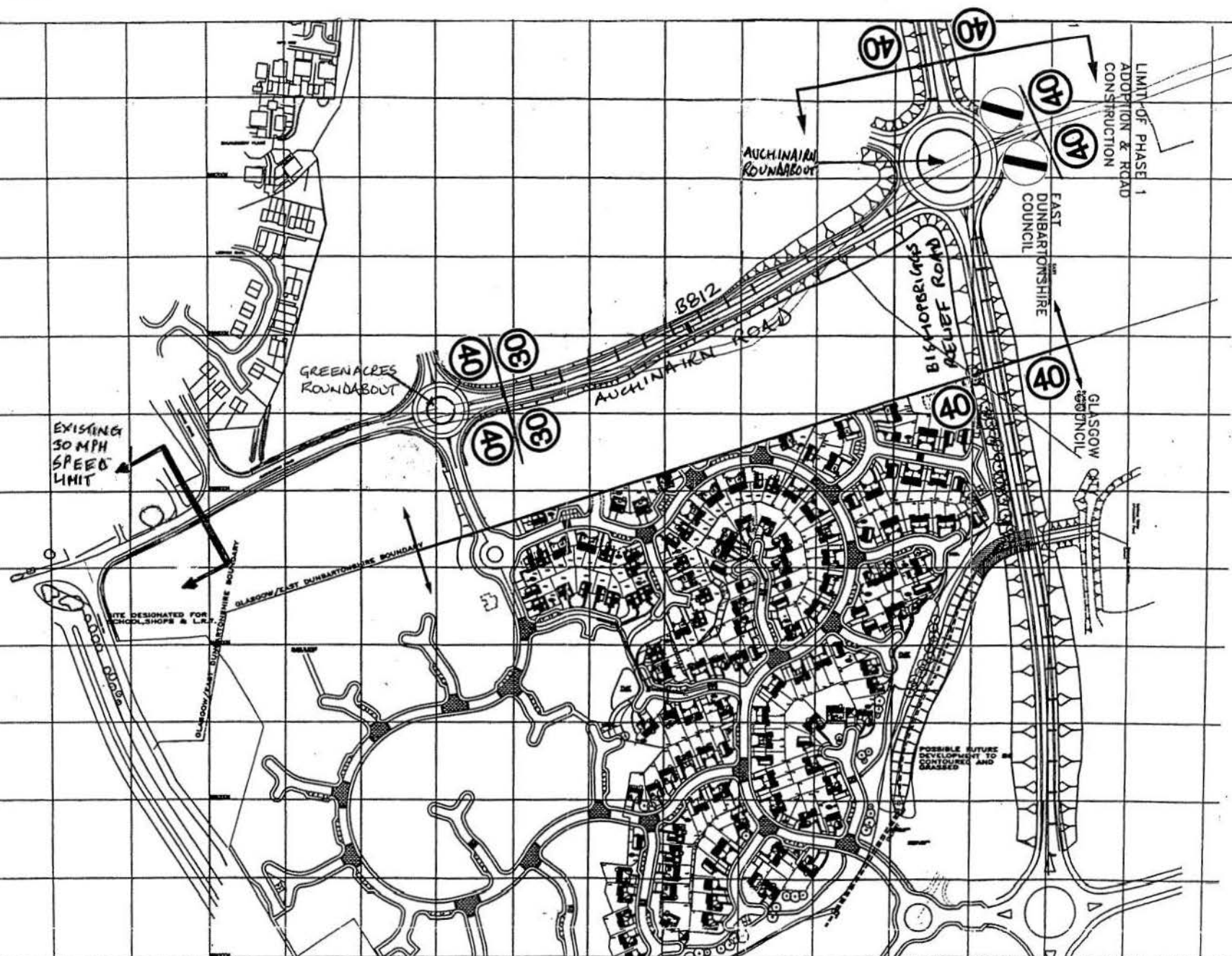
Lengths of Road in East Dunbartonshire

1. That length of the B812, Auchinairn Road from a point 192 metres or thereby northeast of the extended northeast kerbline of Letham Drive, Bishopbriggs, northeastwards for a distance of 385 metres or thereby, including Auchinairn Roundabout.
2. That length of the Unnamed Bishopbriggs Relief Road from the East Dunbartonshire Council/Glasgow City Council boundary northwards for a distance of 200 metres or thereby, including Auchinairn Roundabout.
