

THE EAST DUNBARTONSHIRE COUNCIL
(DESIGNATED DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS)
ORDER 2026

The East Dunbartonshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of the Police Service of Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as "The East Dunbartonshire Council (Designated Disabled Persons' Parking Places and Amendments) Order 2026" and shall come into operation on 24 August 2026;

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"Vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002 as amended.

"Parking Place" means an area on a road which is provided for the leaving of a Vehicle and is indicated in such a manner as prescribed in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 as amended;

"the Council" means the East Dunbartonshire Council, incorporated under the Local Government etc (Scotland) Act 1994;

3. Each area of road which is described in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 to this Order is hereby designated as a Parking Place.
4. The Parking Places designated in Article 3 of this Order shall only be used subject to the provision of this Order for the leaving, at all times, of a Vehicle displaying a valid Disabled Person's Badge.

5. The limits of each Parking Place designated in Article 3 of this Order shall be indicated on the carriageway in such a manner as provided in the Traffic Sign Regulations and General Directions 2016.
6. Every Vehicle displaying a valid Disabled Person's Badge left in a Parking Place designated in Article 3 of this Order shall so stand such that no Parking Place is occupied by more than one such Vehicle and that every part of the Vehicle is within the limits of a Parking Place provided that, where the length of a Vehicle precludes compliance with this paragraph, such Vehicle shall be deemed to be within the limits of a Parking Place if:-
 - (i) the extreme front portion, or, as the case may be, the extreme rear portion of the Vehicle is within 300mm of an indication on the carriageway provided under Article 5 of this Order in relation to the Parking Place; and
 - (ii) the Vehicle, or any part thereof, is not within the limits of any adjoining Parking Place.
7. Any person duly authorised by the Council or a police constable in uniform or a community warden in uniform may move or cause to be moved in case of an emergency, to any place they think fit, Vehicles left in a Parking Place.
8. (i) Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary:-
 - (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety; or
 - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the Parking Place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Parking Place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the Parking Place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus, traffic sign or parking meter; or
 - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Parking Places on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository; or

SCHEDULE 1

Area of Roads Designated as Parking Places for the leaving of a vehicle displaying a Disabled Person's Badge, within Bearsden

East side of Allander Road, South of Teviot Crescent, bounded on the North kerbline, within parking inshot, has a width of around 6.6 metres and extends from a point 45 metres from Deveron Road, heading South, for a distance of around 2.5 metres.

North side of Aviemore Gardens, West of Kinnaird Crescent, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 100 metres from Rannoch Drive, heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Deveron Road, East of Dornoch Road, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 49 metres from Teviot Crescent, heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

South side of Ledcameroch Road, West of Whitehill Road, bounded on the South kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 201 metres from Ledcameroch Crescent, heading West, for a distance of 6.6 metres.

South side of Ledi Drive, West of Cruachan Road, bounded on the South kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 11 metres from Sidlaw Road, heading East, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

West side of Maxwell Avenue, South of North View, bounded on the West kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 49 metres from North View, heading South, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Stockiemuir Avenue, East of Buccleuch Drive, adjacent to Buccleuch Court, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 49.65 metres from Roxburgh Drive, heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Stockiemuir Avenue, East of Buccleuch Drive, adjacent to Buccleuch Court, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 43.70 metres from Roxburgh Drive, heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Thomson Drive, North East of Manse Road, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 115 metres from Kilmardinny Avenue, heading South, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

Area of Roads Designated as Parking Places for the leaving of a vehicle displaying a Disabled Person's Badge, within Bishopbriggs

East side of Access Road off South Crosshill Road, East of Kirkintilloch Road, bounded on the East kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 6 metres from South Crosshill Road, heading south, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

East side of Access Road off South Crosshill Road, East of Kirkintilloch Road, bounded on the East kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 13 metres from South Crosshill Road, heading south, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

East side of Ashfield, North East of Villafield Drive, within residential parking area, (adjacent to number 18), bounded on the East kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 24.5 metres from Murrayfield, heading North, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North East side of Cargill Square, North East of Graham Terrace, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 13 metres from Kincardine Drive, heading North, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Emerson Road, East of Springfield Crescent, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 74 metres from Muir Street, heading East, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

South side of Emerson Road, East of Springfield Crescent, bounded on the South kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 103 metres from Muir Street, heading East, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Fern Avenue, East of Fern Grove, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 43 metres from Larch Avenue, heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

South side of Firpark Road, West of East Springfield Terrace, bounded on the South kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 121.37 metres from Callieburn Road, heading East, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

South side of Firpark Road, West of East Springfield Terrace, bounded on the South kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 128 metres from Callieburn Road, heading East, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

East side of Larch Avenue, North East of Fern Avenue, bounded on the East kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 13 metres from Cedar Road, heading South, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

West side of Lee Crescent, North East of Crowhill Road, bounded on the West kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 91 metres from Emmerson Road West, heading South, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Springfield Road, East of Arnold Avenue, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 27 metres from Younger Quadrant, heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Springfield Square, West of Callieburn Road, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2 metres (1 metre on footway and 1 metre on road) and extends from a point 52 metres from Springfield Crescent, heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

South West side of Woodhill Road, North of Buchanan Drive, bounded on the West kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 162 metres from Wheatley Loan, heading South, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

SCHEDULE 3

Area of Roads Designated as Parking Places for the leaving of a vehicle displaying a Disabled Person's Badge, within Kirkintilloch

South East side of Alexandra Street, Adjacent to Oxford Street, bounded on the South East kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 95 metres from Cowgate, heading North West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

West side of Alloway Drive, North of Mauchline Avenue, bounded on the West kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 38.4 metres from Carrick Court, heading South, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Border Way, East of Eildon Road, bounded on the North Kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 51 metres from Lammermoor Road, heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

West side of Eastermains, South of Ellisland, bounded on the West kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 68 metres from Auchendavie Road, heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

South East side of Ellisland, West of Drumhill, within parking inshot, adjacent to number 119 Ellisland, bounded on the South East kerbline, has a width of around 6.6 metres and extends from a point 14 metres from Ellisland, heading North, for a distance of around 2.5 metres.

North East side of John Street, South of Waterloo Gardens, bounded on the North East kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 30 metres from Hillhead Road, heading South East, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Kingsway, South of Ellisland Drive, within parking inshot, adjacent to number 59, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 134 metres from Ellisland Drive, heading South, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

South East side of Marmion Drive, East of Eildon Road, bounded on the East kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 147 metres from Lammermoor Road, heading South West, for a distance of around 4.2 metres.

North side of Meiklehill Road, West of Newdyke Road, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 16.30 metres from Newdyke Road (adjacent to no 237 Meiklehill Road), heading West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

West side of Meiklehill Road, West of Shells Road, bounded on the West kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 71 metres from Fernlea Road (adjacent to house no 91 within dead end of Road), heading North, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North West side of Regent Street, North East of Queen Street, bounded on the North West kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 28 metres from Oxford Street, heading South West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North East side of The Loaning, North East of Greens Avenue, bounded on the East kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 127 metres from Scotsblair Avenue, heading North West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

East side of Westergreens Avenue, South West of Scotsblair Avenue, bounded on the East kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 80 metres from Parkburn Avenue, heading East, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North side of Cumroch Road, West of Lennox Road, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 71 metres from Kincaid Drive, heading East, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North West side of Lindsay Terrace, West of Bencloich Road, bounded on the North kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 46 metres from Bolton Terrace, heading North East, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.

North East side of Main Street, North East of Margaret Court, bounded on the West kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 38 metres from Greenhead Road, heading North West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres

North East side of Main Street, North East of Margaret Court, bounded on the West kerbline, has a width of around 2.5 metres and extends from a point 24 metres from Greenhead Road, heading North West, for a distance of around 6.6 metres.
