

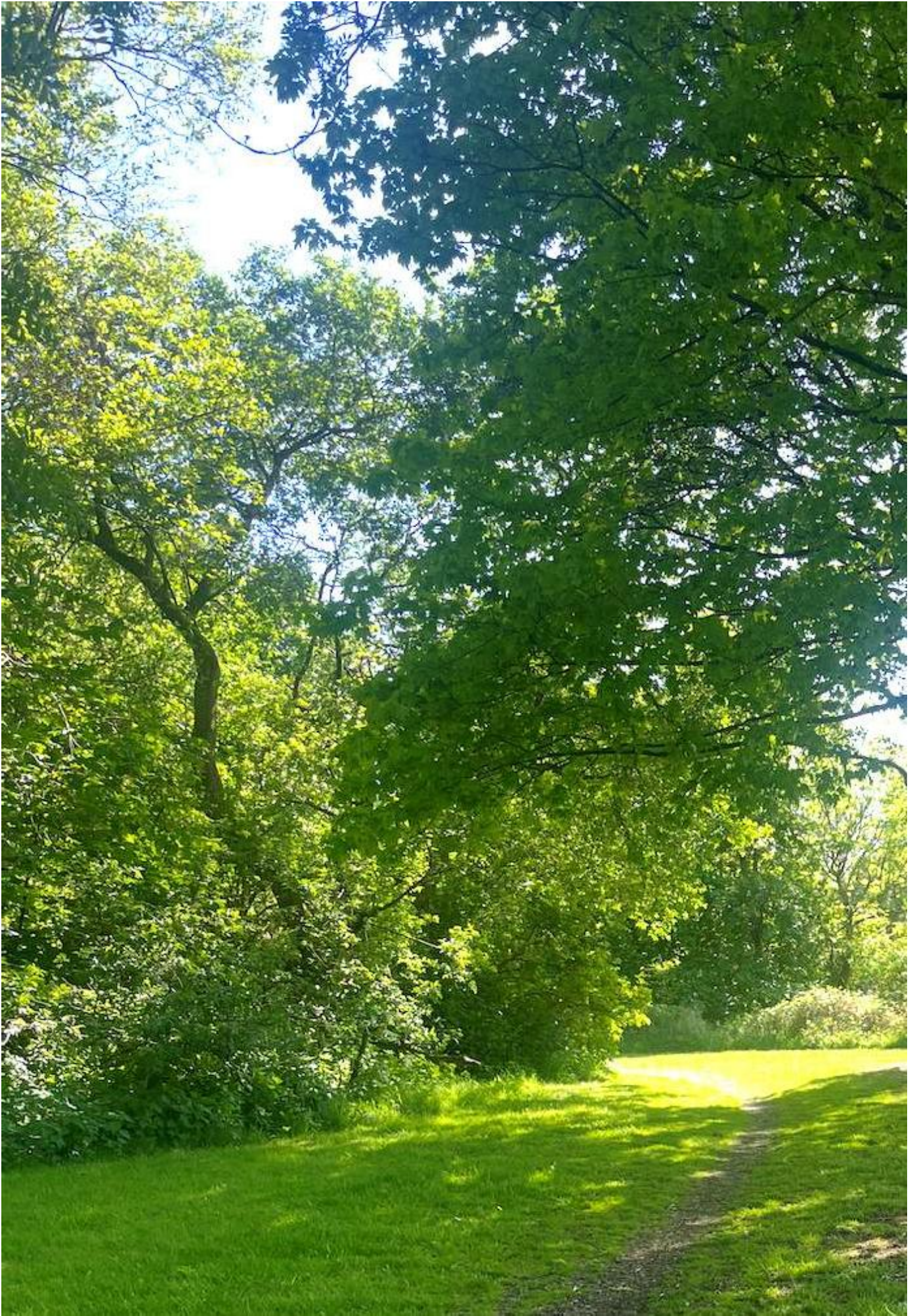

List of the trees planted in the park in the 1980's. Heavy Standard Trees (3.6 to 4.25 metres high)
These were planted to provide immediate visual impact and structure:

- *Acer platanoides* (Norway Maple) – 23 planted

- *Alnus glutinosa* (Common Alder) – 45 planted
-
- *Betula pubescens* (Downy Birch) – 57 planted
-
- *Fraxinus excelsior* (Common Ash) – 19 planted
-
- *Populus tremula* (Aspen) – 14 planted
-
- *Salix alba* (White Willow) – 6 planted
-
- *Sorbus aucuparia* (Rowan/Mountain Ash) – 7 planted

WHIPS (600MM TO 900MM HIGH)

A total of 1,829 whips were planted to establish the denser woodland blocks and structural planting areas:

- *Acer campestre* (Field Maple) – 256 planted

- *Alnus glutinosa* (Common Alder) – 199 planted

- *Corylus avellana* (Hazel) – 81 planted

- *Fagus sylvatica* (Beech) – 202 planted
